What?

The Baltic Leadership Programme on Youth and Bioeconomy addresses the need to better integrate younger generations into the field of Bioeconomy. Youth (up to 30 years of age) are vital for renewing and innovating the sector, which is necessary in the transition from a fossil based to a bio based society/economy, but today necessary links and methods for attracting and involving youth are lacking. In response to this, the Swedish Institute together with its cooperation partners are underway developing a training programme with the intent to tackle the challenges of youth participation in the Bioeconomy sector.

- Network Building

- Stakeholder involvement & multi-actor participation
- Complex thinking (sustainability & stakeholder models setting up interlinkages)
- Communicating complex ideas

The programme will be targeting representatives from youth organisations as well as representatives from organisations working with Bioeconomy in the Baltic Sea Region.
